

## NOTICE TO PARENTS

**TO:** All Parents  
**FROM:** Webster County School District  
**DATE:** August 2, 2011

As the parent of a student enrolled in the Webster County School District, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct each of your children. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers, and it requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to ask the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Whether the Kentucky Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the Kentucky Department of Education has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being fully certified because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major(s); whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any instructional assistants or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and if they do, their qualifications.
